Salvation Army Emergency Welfare Services assists low-income elderly, disabled, veterans, and families catch up on past due bills and avoid utility shut offs. To qualify for the program the household must be below the 150% federal poverty line.

Guidelines: If utilities are shut off they cannot help you. With the beginning of HEAT no help will be given unless they have a 48 hour shutoff notice/ they must also have an appointment scheduled with heat to receive services.
